STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PARTS (a) AND (b) OF RAJYA SABHA STARRED QUESTION NO. 164 ANSWERED ON 21.12.2022 ASKED BY SHRI HARNATH SINGH YADAV REGARDING UPGRADATION AND EXPANSION OF ROAD NETWORK IN THE COUNTRY

(a) This Ministry is primarily responsible for development and maintenance of National Highways (NHs). The total length of NHs has been enhanced to about 1,44,634 km at present. State wise length of NHs in the country at present is at Annexure-I.

Ministry is implementing number of schemes for development of NHs in the country such as Bharatmala Pariyojana including subsumed National Highway Development Project (NHDP), National Highway Original (NHO), Special Accelerated Road Development Programme for North-East Region (SARDP-NE) including Arunachal Package, Special Programme for development of Roads in Left Wing Extremism affected Area (LWE) including Development of Vijayawada-Ranchi Road (LWE) and Externally Aided Projects (EAP). Scheme wise budgetary outlay (BE) for 2022-23 is as under:-
