Schemes to promote industries in Co-operative sector

1605. Shri K.R.N. Rajeshkumar:

Will the Minister of Cooperation be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that various industries such as Dairy, Fertilizer, Agro foods industries etc. are registered and functioning under Co-operative sector;
- (b) if so, whether the Ministry is considering to implement development schemes to promote these industries functioning under Co-operative sector; and
- (c) the details of the schemes, timeline and the funds earmarked for this purpose?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF COOPERATION (SHRI AMIT SHAH)

(a) to (c): Yes, Sir. As per Statistical Profile-2018 published by National Cooperative Union of India (NCUI), there are about 8.54 lakh cooperative societies functioning in various sectors including dairy, fertilizer, agro foods, etc. across the country. The state-wise and sector-wise distribution of cooperative societies is enclosed at **Annexure**.

The Ministry of Cooperation has taken several initiatives to promote the cooperative societies such as:

i. On 29th June 2022, the Ministry launched a centrally sponsored project "Computerization of Primary Agriculture Credit Societies (PACS)" with a budgetary outlay of Rs 2,516 crores for digitalization of 3,000 functional PACS, in three years, which are at the bottom of the rural credit structure. This project will bring transparency and efficiency in their operation. Societies similar to PACS in tribahreas such as Large Area Multipurpose Societies (LAMPS) will also be benefited from the

Computerization of PACS project.

- ii. The Ministry has also prepared Model Byelaws after consultation with all the stakeholders including States/ Union territories. These Model Byelaws of PACS will enable them to undertake more than 25 business activities like dairy, fishery, floriculture, setting up of godowns, procurement of foodgrains, fertilizers, seeds etc. and thus contributing towards the vision of Atamnirbhar Bharat. The cooperatives will bring out these activities in their area of operation.
- iii. National Cooperative Development Corporation (NCDC), a statutory organization under the Ministry of Cooperation, provides financial assistance to the cooperative sector and undertakes various activities such as strengthening share capital base of primary/ District cooperative marketing societies, setting up of processing centres, storage facilities, establishing and modernizing cold chain, creation of cooperative banking units, agricultural services, Integrated Cooperative Development Projects etc.

In addition to above, there are several other schemes of various Ministries/ Departments of Government of India for providing benefits to the cooperatives, such as:

- i. Agriculture Infrastructure fund (Ministry of Agriculture and Farmers Welfare) Interest subvention of 3 % and credit guarantee is provided by the Government for availing loan up to Rs. 2 crore per project for infrastructure projects at farm gate by FPO, PACS, entrepreneurs, start-ups and other beneficiaries.
- ii. Agricultural Marketing Infrastructure (Ministry of Agriculture and Farmers Welfare) Subsidy at the rate of 25% to 33.33% is available to the eligible beneficiaries through the channelizing agencies i.e. NABARD, NCDC, DA&FW, etc. for holistic development of agricultural value chain including promotion of value addition and processing at farmers level so as to enhance their income.
- iii. Sub-Mission on Agricultural Mechanization (SMAM) (Ministry of Agriculture and Farmers Welfare)

 The scheme envisages setting up of custom hiring centers and hubs for hi-tech and high value farm equipment. The equipment will be available on rental basis to the farmers and subsidy at the rate of 40% is available for projects costing upto Rs. 60 lakh.
- iv. Mission for Integrated Development of Horticulture (MIDH) (Ministry of Agriculture and Farmers Welfare) This scheme covers various activities under Horticulture Sector such as setting up of new orchards for fruits, vegetables and flowers, creation of poly-houses, greenhouses, etc. These activities will get subsidy in the range of 25-55%.
- v. Pradhan Mantri Kisan Sampada Yojana (PMKSY) (Ministry of Food Processing Industries) It aims to create modern infrastructure with efficient supply chain management from farm gate to retail outlet. A subsidy of up to 35% of the project cost is provided under this scheme which can go up to 50% in difficult areas for infrastructure facilities such as cold room, cold storage, integrated pack house for primary processing etc.
- vi. PM Formalization of Micro Food Processing Enterprises Scheme (PMFME) (Ministry of Food Processing Industries) The Scheme adopts 'One District One Product' approach. Under the Group category, Cooperatives can avail 35% subsidy (up to ₹10 Lakh) for upgradation of food processing units. ₹ 3 Crore credit-linked grant is available for setting up of common infrastructure like common processing facility, premise for sorting, grading, warehouse and cold storage at farm-gate, incubation centre, etc.
- vii. National Programme for Dairy Development (NPDD) (Department of Animal Husbandry and Dairying) The Scheme aims at enhancing quality of milk and milk products and increase share of organized procurement, processing, value addition and marketing.
- viii. Dairy Processing and Infrastructure Development Fund (DIDF) (Department of Animal Husbandry and Dairying) The Scheme aims to modernize and create milk processing infrastructure, including manufacturing facilities for value added products, milk chilling infrastructure, etc. Loans under this fund will involve an interest subvention of 2.5% per annum.
