OPENING OF NEW KVS IN THE COUNTRY

1623 SHRI DEEPENDER SINGH HOODA:

Will the Minister of **Education** be pleased to state:-

- (a) the fund allocation for the Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan (KVS) for opening new Kendriya Vidyalayas (KVs) in the country during the last five years including the current financial year 2022-23, State-wise and year-wise;
- (b) the number of new KVs opened during the last five years including the current year;
- (c) the number of new KVs that have been made operational during the last five years including current financial year in all the States including Haryana; and
- (d) the number of new KVs that have been approved by Government during the last five years including the current year in all the States including Haryana?

(a) The budgetary support is provided every year as Grants-in-aid to Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan (KVS) on a consolidated basis and not State / UT-wise. The budgetary support is made to KVS under three distinct heads viz. Salaries, General and Creation of Capital Assets for opening and functioning of Kendriya Vidyalayas (KVs). The head-wise details of funds released /allocated to KVS during the last five years including the current financial year 2022-23 are as under:-

(b) & (c) During the last five years including the current financial year i.e. from 2017-18, 113 new KVs under the civil / project / Institute of Higher Learning (IHL) sectors, including 06 KVs in the State of Haryana, have been opened and made functional across the country, taking the total to 1252, with 3 KVs abroad.

(d) During the last five years including the current financial year i.e. from 2017-18, 100 new KVs, including 06 KVs in the State of Haryana, have been approved / sanctioned by the Government under the Civil / Defence sectors across the country.
