STUDENT ADMISSION IN UNIVERSITIES UNDER EWS CATEGORY

1626. SHRI M. MOHAMED ABDULLA:

Will the Minister of *Education* be pleased to state:

(a) the details of number of students who got admission in the Central Universities under

Economically Weaker Section (EWS) reservation for the last two years, State-wise; and

(b) whether it is fact that the EWS category cut-off is less than General category for the last

two years in Central Universities and if so, the reasons therefor?

(a) State-wise details of number of students who got admission in the Central Universities

under Economically Weaker Section (EWS) reservation during the years 2021 and 2022 are

annexed.

(b) Ministry of Education has issued instructions from time to time to all Central Universities

for implementation of SC/ST/PWD/OBC and EWS Reservation Policy of the Government.

Further, the Central Universities are autonomous institutions which are governed by the

Universities' own Acts and Statutes, Ordinances and Regulations made thereunder and are

competent to take all administrative decisions. Cut-offs are decided by the Universities

keeping in mind the Reservation Policy, and no data is maintained centrally.
