**TRAINING CENTRES ESTABLISHED IN BIHAR UNDER PMKVY**

129. SHRI ANEEL PRASAD HEGDE:

Will the Minister of SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP be pleased to state:-

- (a) the total number of training centres established in Bihar, district-wise details thereof, and the number of 10th pass, 12th pass candidates trained under Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana in Bihar, gender-wise details during last five years;
- (b) the number of 10th pass, 12th pass candidates who were trained in Information Technology and IT enabled services (IT-ITeS) sector for job roles in basic computer education under the third phase of PMKVY 3.0; and
- (c) whether the Ministry has been able to engage apprentices amongst the trainees in Bihar, if so, details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

**ANSWER**

(a) Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship (MSDE) is delivering skills to the youth of the country including State of Bihar through a network of skill development centres. Under Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PMKVY), short term training is being imparted in empanelled training centres (TCs) including model and aspirational training centres known as Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Kendra (PMKK).

The district-wise number of PMKVY training centres (TCs) including PMKKs in the State of Bihar is given at *Column (a) of Annexure*. The gender-wise number of 10<sup>th</sup> pass and 12<sup>th</sup> pass candidates trained/oriented under PMKVY in the State of Bihar since 2016 upto 30.09.2022 is given at *Column (b) of Annexure*.

(b) The 10<sup>th</sup> pass and 12<sup>th</sup> pass candidates trained in Information Technology and IT enabled services (IT-ITeS) sector including basic computer education job roles across the country and State of Bihar under PMKVY 3.0 is given below:
