- (a) Whether Government is aware that the management of a database of Adverse Drug Reactions (ADR) is crucial towards ensuring safety of a drug; and
- (b) If so, the details of steps taken by Government to establish and manage such database?

(a) & (b): The Government is aware about need for ensuring safety of drugs for which it has created network of 652 Adverse Drug Reaction (ADR) Monitoring Centres pan India under Pharmacovigilance Programme of India (PvPI). The inputs from these ADR monitoring centres go into the database of PvPI.
