GREENFIELD AIRPORTS IN TELANGANA

(a) to (e): During last five years, Government of India (GoI) has accorded 'In-Principle' approval for development of International Greenfield Airport at Noida (Jewar), Uttar Pradesh and Domestic Greenfield Airport at Itangar, Arunachal Pradesh. Besides, Government of India has also granted 'Site Clearance' to the State Government of Himachal Pradesh (GoHP) for construction of a greenfield airport at Mandi, Himachal Pradesh. In the last five years eight Greenfield airports namely Pakyong, Kannur, Kalaburagi, Oravakal, Sindhudurg, Kushinagar, Donyi Polo, Itanagar and Manohar Airport, Mopa have been operationalised.

The timeline for construction of airports depends upon various factors such as land acquisition, mandatory clearances, removal of obstacles, financial closure etc. by the respective airport developers.
