Will the Minister of *Housing and Urban Affairs* be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of the work carried out under the National Heritage City Development and Augmentation Yojana (HRIDAY) in the city of Amravati, Andhra Pradesh since 2015, the details thereof;
- (b) whether Government plans to integrate more cities under the scheme from the current strength of 12 to more, if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) whether the scheme has a provision for private funding, if so, the quantum of private funding that has been mobilized to date to ensure protection and conservation of these historic cities/monuments, the details thereof?

(a): The following work done under the HRIDAY scheme in Amravati, Andhra Pradesh during the mission period:

- (i). Up-gradation of Approach roads to Heritage Sites
- (ii). Development of Heritage Walk
- (iii). Development of Amaravati Pond (Nunegundam Cheruvu)

(b): The mission period of HRIDAY scheme ended on 31st March, 2019 and therefore no new proposals can be approved.
