INTEGRATION OF MPLADS PROCESSES ON A UNIFIED PORTAL

Will the Minister of STATISTICS AND PROGRAMME IMPLEMENTATION be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Government contemplating to fully integrate the MPLADS processes through a completely unified portal for the effective utilization of local development funds earmarked for the Members of Parliament; and

(b) if so, the details thereof;

(c) whether Government has received any inputs or suggestions concerning proactive monitoring of every activity, including submission of the project, and to expedite the implementation of the project by integrating all such activities through an e-portal; and

(d) if so, the details thereof?

(a) to (d) The Ministry of Statistics and Programme Implementation, in collaboration with State Bank of India, has developed a web-portal for implementing revised fund flow procedure in accordance with instructions issued by Ministry of Finance, Department of Expenditure vide its O.M. No.1(18)/PFMS/FCD/2021, dated 9-3-2022 and O.M.No.3/(07)/PFMS/2022, dated 27-9-2022. The revised fund flow procedure shall also be in line with MPLADS Guidelines that has been revised based on the suggestions/inputs received from various stakeholders, including Hon'ble MPs, which were found feasible and aligned with the objectives of MPLAD Scheme. The new Guidelines and the web-portal will be effective from 1-4-2023.

The new web-portal incorporates several technology-enabled functionalities covering the entire lifecycle of development project under MPLADS, including online work recommendations, online sanction/rejection, online monitoring system through dashboards, etc. The new system is expected to bring greater transparency and accountability in the MPLAD Scheme.
