DATA ON WOMEN MIGRANT WORKERS

1850. SHRI NIRANJAN BISHI:

Will the Minister of Labour and Employment be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government has data on women migrant workers migrating due to marriage;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor;
- (c)whether Government has data concerning skill levels at which migrant women workers are employed, if so, the details thereof;
- (d)whether Government has data with respect to number of women migrant workers engaged as domestic workers; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE FOR LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT (SHRI RAMESWAR TELI)

(a) to (e): As per Census 2011 total 20.58 crore females are migrated due to Marriage and as per this census the number of women migrant workers is 64 lakh across the country. Besides, this Ministry has launched e-SHRAM portal, a National Database of the Unorganised Workers on 26th August, 2021. e-SHRAM allows registration under 30 broad occupation sectors and around 400 occupations.

As on 13.03.2023, 2.79 crore domestic & household workers have registered on e-shram portal out of which 2.67 crore are women.
