Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of people having got their names registered in Ayushman Bharat Health Mission under the 'Swastha Mann-Swastha Ghar' campaign, State-wise;
- (b) the details of people getting the benefits of Ayushman Bharat Health Mission, Statewise;
- (c) whether the registration of people in the States is being undertaken through voluntary organisations; and
- (d) if so, the name wise details thereof?

(a) to (d): As on 28.02.2023 a total of 1,57,698 AB-HWCs have been operationalized across the country to deliver Comprehensive Primary Health Care (CPHC) that includes preventive, promotive, curative, palliative and rehabilitative services which are universal, free, and closer to the community.

A year-long campaign is being conducted from November 2022 to October 2023 with the tagline 'Swastha Mann, Sawastha Ghar' under the theme Health and Wellness to commemorate the 'Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav' (AKAM). Campaign has now been renamed as 'Arogyam- overall well being'. For increasing the community participation during this campaign, the Government of India has started Health mela initiatives. Under these initiatives comprehensive health activities and health check-up camps are organised at transformed Ayushman Bharat- Health and Wellness Centres.

As reported by States/UTs on AB-HWC portal till the month of February, 2023, 34 States/UTs have organised Health Melas. A total of 2,57,275 ABHA ID are created, 1,00,774 golden cards under Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojna Scheme have been issued and 2,50,972 Teleconsultation through E-Sanjeevani platforms have been provided in these Health Melas. A total number of 147.32 crore footfall has been recorded on AB-HWCs during the period between 2018 to 2022. State-wise details are at **Annexure**.

As per guidelines Jan Arogya Samiti/Village Health Sanitation & Nutrition Committee/Mahila Arogya Samiti members, Panchayati Raj Institutions members, School teachers, Anganwadi workers etc. participates in the Mela and to mobilise the beneficiary in large number.
