TOURISM INFRASTRUCTURE IN THE NORTH-EAST

1905 SHRI BIPLAB KUMAR DEB:

Will the Minister of **TOURISM** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Ministry is aware that North- East Region of the country presents a tremendous untapped potential for the growth of tourism sector;
- (b) the details of the initiatives taken by the Ministry to attract tourists from across the world to the North-East parts of the country during the last three years, State-wise; and
- (c) the details of the funds utilised for development of tourism infrastructure in the North-East during the last three years, State-wise, year-wise?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF TOURISM

(SHRI G. KISHAN REDDY)

(a) & (b): The North Eastern Region (NER) is endowed with diverse tourist attractions and each State has its own distinct features. The Ministry of Tourism places special emphasis on the development and promotion of tourism for North Eastern States by providing financial assistance under different schemes such as Swadesh Darshan, PRASHAD & Infrastructure Development Division which includes assistance for development of tourist infrastructure, promotion of fairs/festivals, tourism related events in the region, publicity campaigns etc.

International Tourism Mart (ITM) is an annual event organised by the Ministry of Tourism in the North Eastern region with the objective of highlighting the tourism potential of the region in the domestic and international Market. On 17th and 18th November, 2022 the ITM was held at Aizwal, Mizoram. Since April 2020, under Dekho Apna Desh campaign, the Ministry of Tourism is conducting webinars on various tourism products including NER and some of the webinars were dedicated to North East Region. Tourism & Culture Minister's conference was also organized in September, 2021 which was attended by Hon'ble Chief Minister of Assam, Hon'ble Union Minister of Tourism, Culture and DoNER, Hon'ble Union Minister of State for Tourism, Hon'ble Union Minister of State for Culture & Parliamentary Affairs, Tourism and Culture Ministers of the North-Eastern States, officials from Central and State Governments and stakeholders from the Travel and Hospitality Industry.

Ministry of Tourism is also augmenting tourism infrastructure and connectivity in the region in coordination with Ministry of Civil Aviation through the Regional Connectivity Scheme (RCS)- UDE DESH KA AAM NAGRIK (UDAN). In an effort to promote Tourism, Ministry of Tourism is also providing financial assistance for construction of a Convention Centre at Aizawl and View Points on highways of North Eastern States.
