EFFICIENT STORAGE SYSTEMS FOR AGRICULTURAL PRODUCE IN UTTAR PRADESH

2792 # SHRI MITHLESH KUMAR:

Will the Minister of CONSUMER AFFAIRS, FOOD AND PUBLIC DISTRIBUTION be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government has taken any initiative to develop efficient storage systems (warehouses, godowns, cold stores, integrated cold chains, etc.) at block and regional level for agricultural produce in Uttar Pradesh;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) if not, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE FOR MINISTRY OF RURAL DEVELOPMENT AND CONSUMER AFFAIRS, FOOD & PUBLIC DISTRIBUTION (SADHVI NIRANJAN JYOTI)

(a) to (c):- To identify the blocks having no storage facility, a survey was conducted by National Bank for Agriculture and Rural Development (NABARD). Based on that data, 925 blocks (Annexure-A) were identified where no storage infrastructure was available. Ministry of Consumer Affairs, Food & Public Distribution has requested state governments to develop warehousing facilities in these blocks using various schemes of central and state governments e.g. Agriculture Infrastructure Fund (AIF), Mission for Integrated Development of Horticulture (MIDH) for cold storage and Agriculture Marketing Infrastructure (AMI) etc.

However, Storage capacity of FCI depends upon the level of procurement, requirement of buffer norms and PDS operations. Storage gap is assessed in the procuring States based on the highest stock levels in the last three years and in the consuming States on the basis of 4 months (6 months in case of North Eastern States and in some other states like J&K, Ladakh, Himachal Pradesh, Uttarakhand, Andaman & Nicobar and Lakshadweep) requirement of NFSA and OWS.

FCI continuously assesses and monitors the storage capacity and based on the storage gap assessment, storage capacities are created/hired through the following schemes: -

- 1. Construction of Silo's under PPP mode
- 2. Private Entrepreneurs Guarantee (PEG) Scheme
- 3. Central Sector Scheme (CSS)
- 4. Hiring of godown from CWCs/SWCs/State Agencies
- 5. Hiring of godown through Private Warehousing Scheme (PWS)

Total number of godowns of FCI in Uttar Pradesh is 244 with storage capacity of 44.28 LMT including owned and hired.

Besides, Central Warehousing Corporation (CWC) is having 51 warehouses with total storage capacity of 12.87 LMT in state of Uttar Pradesh (Annexure-B)
