

(d) the steps being taken to speed up the construction work of power projects, keeping in view the backwardness and the acute electricity problem in this area?

THE MINISTER OF POWER (SHRI SUSHIL KUMAR SHINDE): (a) Maharashtra State Power Generation Company Ltd. (MAHAGENCO) has intimated that in the Vidarbha region of Maharashtra the following three generation projects have been identified for completion in the XI Plan under the State Sector:

1. Paras Thermal Power Project (TPP) Expansion Unit-1 (250 MW)
2. Paras TPP Expansion Unit-2 (250 MW)
3. Khaperkheda TPP Expansion (500 MW)

(b) MAHAGENCO has further reported that Paras TPP Expansion Unit-1 (250 MW) has been commissioned on 31.05.2007. No other project is expected to be completed within one year.

(c) The commissioning of Paras TPP Expansion Unit-1 has been delayed by 6 months with respect to the contractual schedule due to delay in supply and erection of equipment by the supplier. Presently, no delay is envisaged in other ongoing projects.

(d) In terms of contractual schedules, the Paras TPP Expansion Unit-2 (250 MW) and Khaperkheda TPP Expansion (500 MW) are scheduled to be commissioned in April, 2009 and March, 2010 respectively. The progress of construction of projects is being regularly monitored.

Goals to achieve literacy

*60. SHRI RAVULA CHANDRA SEKAR REDDY: Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

(a) details regarding the goals set to achieve literacy in the country especially in Andhra Pradesh during the last year, year-wise; and

(b) the present position thereof in that State?

THE MINISTER OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (SHRI ARJUN SINGH): (a) and (b) The goal of the National Literacy Mission is to achieve 75% literacy rate by 2007. No year-wise goals have been set in this regard. No assessment of the achievement has been made.

The Approach Paper to the XI Plan of the Planning Commission has set a target of achieving 85% literacy rate by the end of the Plan period. Government of Andhra Pradesh, aims to achieve the literacy level of 95% by end of 11th plan.
