- (d) if so, the details thereof?

STARRED QUESTION NO. 55* FOR 7TH FEBRUARY, 2023**

(a) to (d): Under the National Covid vaccination programme Precaution dose is available free of cost in public health facilities for all eligible beneficiaries above 18 years, after an interval of 6 months from the date of administration of the 2nd dose. Precaution dose is also available at Private Covid Vaccination Centers on payment basis.

Union Ministry of Health is following COVID-19 trajectory globally and in the country. Indian SARS-CoV -2 Genomics Consortium (INSACOG) network laboratories are conducting whole genome sequencing of samples for detection of mutant variants of the virus.

The guidelines for international arrivals are updated regularly and uploaded on website of Ministry of Health & Family Welfare.

As per the updated guidelines, Pre-departure testing and uploading of negative COVID-19 RT-PCR test reports and self-health declaration form on Air Suvidha portal are applicable for travellers coming from/transiting via China, Singapore, Hong Kong, Republic of Korea, Thailand and Japan. Besides specific guidelines for these identified high risk countries, a sub-section (2% of the total passengers in all incoming international flights) shall undergo random post arrival testing at the airport on arrival, irrespective of port of departure.
