2052. SHRI JAWHAR SIRCAR:

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) the reasons for low budgetary allocation to Mumbai, Kolkata-Howrah-Sealdah railway terminals when 88 and 82 per cent respectively of their passengers are in the suburban category;
- (b) whether it is a fact that they are not profitable and expenditure is more than ten times the earnings;
- (c) the total budget and expenditure on these two major suburban railway services and of Chennai, per year; and
- (d) percentage of total railway budget that goes to these three suburban railways that carry over 60 per cent of total railway passengers?

STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PARTS (a) TO (d) OF UNSTARRED QUESTION NO. 2052 BY SHRI JAWHAR SIRCAR ANSWERED IN RAJYA SABHA ON 17.03.2023 REGARDING SUBURBAN RAILWAY SERVICES.

(a) & (b) The suburban services of Mumbai are served by Central and Western Railway and Kolkata-Howrah-Sealdah suburban services are served by Eastern Railway, South Eastern Railway and Metro Railway. Railway budget for both revenue and capital expenditure is allotted to these zones based on their requirement and resource availability. The budget allotment is for maintenance and creation of entire rail infrastructure which is being used to operate all services including suburban. These suburban services are not profitable and in 2021-22, their expenses were ranging from 5 to 9 times of their revenues.

(c) & (d) Budget allotment to the zonal Railways concerned in RE 2021-22 is given below:
