(a) to (d): National Education Policy (NEP), 2020 provides for setting up Gender Inclusion Fund (GIF) to build nation's capacity to provide equitable quality education for all girls as well as transgender students. NEP, 2020 identifies transgender children as Socio-Economically Disadvantaged Groups (SEDGs). The above objectives of NEP for equitable and quality education for girls and transgender children are being met through specific provisions under Samagra Shiksha 2.0 by allocating dedicated resources for SEDGs. This includes provisions for assisting transgender children in gaining access to education, support for community-based interventions that address local context-specific barriers to transgender children's access to and participation in education, thereby aiming to eliminate any remaining disparity in access to education (including vocational education) for children from any gender or other SEDGs. The details of such provisions and resources allocated under Samagra Shiksha 2.0 for the year 2022-23 are as under:
