REDEVELOPMENT OF RAILWAY STATIONS

306. SHRI VIKRAMJIT SINGH SAHNEY :

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that Railways awarded contract worth Rupees 12,461 crore for redevelopment of 32 Stations in 2022, if so, the station-wise details thereof;
- (b) the details of the contract allocated for various railway stations in Punjab and Chandigarh and the timeline of completion of redevelopment of these railway stations;
- (c) whether Government is planning to add more railway stations from Punjab under this redevelopment plan; and
- (d) if so, details thereof, and if not, reasons therefor?

STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PARTS (a) TO (d) OF UNSTARRED QUESTION NO 306 BY SHRI VIKRAMJIT SINGH SAHNEY ANSWERED IN RAJYA SABHA ON 03.02.2023 REGARDING REDEVELOPMENT OF RAILWAY STATIONS

(a) to (d): Modernisation/upgradation/redevelopment of Railway stations is a continuous and ongoing process subject to traffic, inter-se priority of works and availability of funds and these works are generally carried out through the Plan Head Customer Amenities (PH-53). The works are planned for efficient execution depending upon the type/size of work, its geographic location etc. As a single work may cover a number of stations and similarly a single station may be covered by a number of works, the station-wise details of contracts are not maintained. However, the details of major contracts awarded for redevelopment of stations during 2022-23 (upto January 2023) are appended:-

Ministry of Railways has identified 31 railway stations from State of Punjab and Union Territory of Chandigarh for development under the Amrit Bharat Station Scheme. These stations are Chandigarh, Ludhiana, Jalandhar Cantt., Amritsar, Beas, Bhatinda Jn., Jalandhar City, Pathankot Cantt., Abohar, Anandpur Sahib, Fazilka, Firozpur Cantt., Gurdaspur, Kotkapura, Kapurthala, Dhuri, Dhandari Kalan, Malerkotla, Muktsar, Moga, Mansa, Nangal Dam, Patiala, Phagwara, Pathankot City, Phillur, Rup Nagar, Sahibzada Ajeet Singh Nagar (SASN) Mohali, Sangrur, Sirhind, Hoshiarpur.

Development/redevelopment/upgradation of Railway Stations is complex in nature involving safety of passengers and trains and requires various statutory clearances from urban/local bodies etc. and these factors affect the completion time. Therefore, no time frame can be indicated.
