**PROMOTION OF TRIBAL CULTURE IN MAHARASHTRA**

814. DR. ANIL SUKHDEORAO BONDE:

Will the Minister of *CULTURE* be pleased to state:

- (a) the schemes run by Government for promotion of tribal culture, tribal museum, etc., in the State of Maharashtra and the financial assistance given for the purpose;
- (b) the details of the funds/grants provided to various organizations/institutions for the said purpose during the years 2019 to 2022, and the criteria for considering proposals for grant of funds, Institution-wise; and
- (c) whether Government has received any requests/proposals from the State Government of Maharashtra for grant of assistance to the private institutes for the said purpose and if so, the details thereof and the action taken thereon?

**ANSWER**

- (a) Ministry of Tribal Affairs (MoTA) is administrating the Centrally Sponsored Scheme “Support of Tribal Research Institutes” under which grants are given to the State Tribal Research Institutes (TRIs) for various projects including preservation and promotion of their art, culture, practices, traditions in following ways:
  - (i) Research studies/publication of books/documentation including audio visual documentaries on promotion of rich tribal cultural heritage which includes preservation of tribal languages.
  - (ii) Tribal cultural exchange programmes.

- (iii) Research and documentation of Indigenous practices by tribal healers and medicinal plants, Adivasi Languages, agriculture system, dances and paintings, organization of literary festivals, publication of books written by tribal writers/ authors, translation works and literature competitions, etc.
- (iv) To acknowledge the heroic and patriotic deeds of tribal unsung heroes, Ministry has sanctioned setting up Tribal Freedom Fighters Museum for ten states. These museums along with ethnographic Tribal museums will also showcase and preserve tribal artefacts related to life and culture of tribes.
- (v) Ministry gives funding to States/UTs for organizing tribal festival at State level like Hornbill festival of Nagaland, Medaram Jatra of Telangana.
- (vi) The Ethnographic Museum of the states preserve and showcase rare artifacts related to life and culture of various tribes.

Besides, Ministry of Culture operates Museum Grant Scheme under which financial assistance is provided to Central/State Governments, Societies, Autonomous bodies, local bodies, Academic Institutions, Public Sector Undertakings and Trusts registered under Societies Registration Act, 1860 for establishment/development of new/existing museums including Tribal Museums at regional state and district level.

- (b) The details of the funds/grants released to various organization/institutions under the scheme “Support to Tribal Research Institutes” and for establishment/ development of museums under the Museum Grant Schemes during the year 2019 to 2022 are at **Annexure-I & II** respectively. The proposals received in consonance with scheme guidelines are considered for financial assistance.
