**CONSTRUCTION OF ROADS UNDER KMMTTP**

Will the Minister of EXTERNAL AFFAIRS be pleased to state :-

- (a) whether Government has any plan to finish the construction of Lawngtlai to Zorinpui to Paletwa to Sittwa Sea-Port road in 2023 under Kaladan Multi-Modal Transit Transport Project (KMMTTP);
- (b) the total amount of funds sanctioned for this project; and
- (c) the names of Contractors/Companies involved in the implementation of this project?

**ANSWER**

(a to c) The Kaladan Multi Modal Transit Transport Project (KMMTTP) includes a waterways component of 158 Km on the Kaladan river from Sittwe Port to Paletwa in Myanmar and a road component of 109 Km from Paletwa to Zorinpui on the India-Myanmar border in Mizoram state. Government of India has sanctioned Rs.1921.05 crores for the road component. IRCON International has been appointed as Project Implementing Agency for execution of the project in March 2022. Work has commenced from both Paletwa and Zorinpui end.
