#### EDUCATIONALLY BACKWARD DISTRICTS IDENTIFIED BY UGC

671. DR. C.M. RAMESH:

Will the Minister of EDUCATION be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of districts in different States of the country identified as educationally backward by UGC, State-wise details thereof;
- (b) the steps taken by UGC and the Ministry to improve the educational standards in those districts, details thereof; and
- (c) the criteria adopted by the UGC to declare districts of any State as educationally backward, details thereof?

#### **ANSWER**

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION (Dr. SUBHAS SARKAR)

(a) to (c): An Expert Committee constituted by the University Grants Commission (UGC) had identified 374 Educationally Backward Districts (EBDs) where Gross Enrolment Ratio (GER) in higher education was less than the national average of 12.4% based on 2001 census data. The State-wise details of the number of EBDs State-wise are annexed.

Education being in the Concurrent List, enhancing the quality of education is the responsibility of both the Central and State Governments. However, recognizing the need for central assistance, the Central Government has implemented various schemes for supporting State Governments. Under the erstwhile scheme of providing financial assistance to new Model Degree Colleges (MDCs) in EBDs, UGC had approved assistance to 64 MDCs in EBDs. This scheme has been subsumed under Rashtriya Uchchatar Shiksha Abhiyan (RUSA), a centrally sponsored scheme of Department of Higher Education with the aim to promote access, equity and quality, inter alia. RUSA provides central assistance to States for creation of Model Degree Colleges, Infrastructure grants to college and universities, etc. The Project Approval Board (PAB) of RUSA has approved an amount of Rs. 5,896.33 crores, under various components in the identified EBDs in the country.
