INCREASE IN CRIME IN DELHI

Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

(a) whether Government is aware that an increase in the incidents of women harassment, rape, chain snatching, theft and robbery has been registered in Delhi, if so, the details thereof during the last five years;

(b) whether any analysis has been made regarding increase in crime against women and if so, the details thereof, along with remedial measures being taken;

(c) the number of criminal cases that have been registered in Delhi in the last three years; and

(d) the number of cases solved and the number of culprits caught on the registered complaints?

(a) and (b): As reported by Delhi Police, the number of cases reported against women harassment, rape and total cases of chain snatching, theft and robbery during the last five years is as under:

Thus, the data given above does not suggest increase in crime against women. However, Delhi Police continuously analyses and monitors the trend of crime, and augments its response mechanism accordingly. Concrete measures taken by Delhi Police in this regard include - dynamic identification of crime prone areas and deployment of police resources including pickets, foot patrolling, PCR Vans and Emergency Response Vehicles to enhance visibility and prevent crime; identification, surveillance and arrest of active criminals; self-defence training program for women and children; women safety committee at Police Stations level; exclusive help desks for women in Police stations; integrated patrolling by local police, PCR staff and traffic police; and community policing programmes.

(c) and (d): The details of criminal cases registered, solved and accused persons arrested by Delhi Police during the last three years are as under:
