**MONITORING OF BRIDGE ON NHs**

744. SHRI MITHLESH KUMAR:

Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS be pleased to State:

- (a) whether the Ministry has appointed a consultant to develop Bridge Management System (BMS) for providing an online platform to monitor the status of bridges on National Highways in the country;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) the list of number of the old and dilapidated bridges handed over to Government by the consultant in the country so far; and
- (d) the details thereof?

(a) to (d) Yes Sir, Ministry has deployed a Consultancy Organization in November 2022 to develop Indian Bridge Management System (IBMS), which is an online platform to monitor the status of Bridges interalia dilapidated/ distressed bridges on NHs in the Country, which gets operational on completion of development of IBMS including data collection. Whenever the bridges on NHs are found in dilapidated/ distressed condition those are rehabilitated/ reconstructed as per requirement.
