Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that the Union Government spends the least on healthcare in the country, particularly on per-capita basis from the year 2014 and if so, the reasons therefor;
- (b) whether it is fact that the Union Government's expenditure on healthcare in the country was only around 1.2 per cent of GDP since 2014 except 2020-21 because of COVID-19 pandemic; and
- (c) the details about the Healthcare expenditure by the Union Government, State-wise and year-wise from the year 2019?
