**STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PARTS (a) & (b) OF THE RAJYA SABHA  
STARRED QUESTION NO. 195 BY DR.SIKANDER KUMAR TO BE ANSWERED ON  
7<sup>TH</sup> AUGUST, 2023 REGARDING ‘PRADHAN MANTRI UJJWALA YOJANA(PMUY)’**

(a) & (b) Pradhan Mantri Ujjwala Yojana (PMUY) was started in May, 2016 with an objective to provide clean cooking fuel to poor households across the country. Under PMUY, a deposit free LPG connection is provided in the name of adult woman member of poor households. The target to release 8 crore connections under PMUY Phase-I was achieved in September, 2019. To cover the remaining poor households, PMUY phase-2 (Ujjwala 2.0) was launched in August 2021 with a target to release 1 crore additional PMUY connections, which was achieved in January 2022. Subsequently, the Government decided to release 60 lakh more LPG connections under Ujjwala 2.0 and the target of 1.60 crore under Ujjwala 2.0 connections was achieved in December, 2022.

As on 01.07.2023, there are 1.41 lakh PMUY beneficiaries in the State of Himachal Pradesh. District-wise details are at **Annexure**.
