Vacancies in public sector banks

1009. SHRI BINOY VISWAM:

Will the Minister of FINANCE be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of sanctioned staff across categories in Public Sector Banks (PSB) currently, PSB-wise and year-wise data since 2019;
- (b) the number of year-wise vacancies in PSBs since 2019;
- (c) the number of jobs advertised by PSBs since 2019 across categories, including through IBPS and SBI recruitment, year-wise; and
- (d) the number of positions added to the existing staff since 2019?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE (DR. BHAGWAT KARAD)

(a) to (d): Public Sector Banks (PSBs), being board governed commercial entities, undertake manpower planning and assessment every year with the approval of their respective Board. While undertaking the manpower assessment various factors like business requirement, spread of activities, superannuation, other unplanned exits etc., are taken into account. Accordingly, the recruitment of staff varies from year to year based on the specific requirements of each bank.

PSBs have informed that a total number of 136,377 jobs have been advertised (including through IBPS and SBI) during FY 2019-20 to 2022-23, across categories. Details are as under:
