**Quantum of coal supplied to Tamil Nadu**

**41 Shri R. Girirajan:**

**Will the Minister of Coal be pleased to state:**

- (a) the year-wise, power plant-wise details of the quantity and value (in INR) of coal supplied to thermal power stations in Tamil Nadu;
- (b) whether Government has received any plea or request from the State Government of Tamil Nadu regarding the shortage of supply of coal and if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the details of the quantity and value (in INR) of coal supplied to industries, both public sector and private sector, in Tamil Nadu?

**(a):** The year-wise, power plant-wise details of the coal quantity (in Million Tonnes) supplied to the thermal power plants in Tamil Nadu and the values (in ₹ Crore) for the year 2021-22, 2022-23 & 2023-24 (till October'23) is at **Annexure-A**.

**(b):** Supply of coal to the power plants is a continuous process. Requests are received from various States, including Tamil Nadu, regarding coal supplies. Coal supply is continuously monitored by the coal companies and also by an Inter-Ministerial Sub Group comprising of representatives from Ministry of Power, Ministry of Coal, Ministry of Railways, Central Electricity Authority (CEA), Coal India Limited (CIL) and Singareni Collieries Company Limited (SCCL), which meets regularly to take various operational decisions to enhance supply of coal to Thermal Power Plants as well as for meeting any contingent situations relating to Power Sector including to alleviate critical coal stock position in power plants.

In addition to this, an Inter-Ministerial Committee (IMC) has been constituted comprising of Chairman, Railway Board; Secretary, Ministry of Coal; Secretary, Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change and Secretary, Ministry of Power; to monitor augmentation of coal supply and power generation capacity. Secretary, Ministry of New and Renewable Energy and Chairperson, CEA are co-opted as Special Invitees as and when required by the IMC.

**(c):** The details of the quantity (in Million Tonnes) and value (in ₹ crore) of the coal supplied by CIL and SCCL to the industries both of Public Sector and Private Sector in Tamil Nadu for the year 2021-22, 2022-23 & 2023-24 (till October'23) is as below:
