Projects under PM-DevINE Scheme

Will the Minister of Development of North Eastern Region be pleased to State:

- (a) the date of launch of the Prime Minister's Development Initiative for North East Region (PM-DevINE) Scheme dedicated to the development of North East region;
- (b) the amount being spent on the said Scheme;
- (c) the benefits that North East India will get from said Scheme; and
- (d) by when it is targeted to complete the ongoing projects in North-Eastern region under the Scheme?

ANSWER

(a) & (b) Prime Minister's Development Initiative for North East Region (PM-DevINE) was announced in the Union Budget 2022-23 as a new Central Sector scheme with 100% Central funding and the scheme was approved by the Union Cabinet on 12th October, 2022, with a total scheme outlay of Rs.6,600 crore for the 4 years period from 2022-23 to 2025-26 (remaining years of the 15th Finance Commission period).

(c) The PM-DevINE scheme aims at rapid and holistic development of NER by funding infrastructure and social development projects based on felt needs of the States. The objectives of PM-DevINE scheme are to: (i) fund infrastructure convergently, in the spirit of PM GatiShakti; (ii) support social development projects based on felt needs of the NER; (iii) enable livelihood activities for youth and women; and (iv) fill the development gaps in various sectors.

(d) The projects sanctioned under the scheme are targeted to be completed by 2025-26.
