TRIBAL LITERACY RATE IN INDIA

464 Shri A. A. Rahim:

Will the Minister of Tribal Affairs be pleased to state:

- (a) the tribal literacy rate, State-wise;
- (b) the details of States that have special schemes to increase Tribal literacy rate; and
- (c) the number of students from STs enrolled in schools, State-wise, enrollment ratio among the ST population and the pass percentage for the 10th standard and 12th standard or equivalent?

ANSWER

(a): As per Periodic Labour Force Survey (PLFS) report (July 2021 - June 2022), published by Ministry of Statistics & Programme Implementation (MoSPI), estimated literacy rate for Scheduled Tribes in India is 72.1%. However, State-wise details of literacy rates are not available in PLFS report. The State-wise literacy rate in respect of Scheduled Tribes as per Census 2011 is given at **Annexure I**.

(b): In order to bridge this gap in literacy, the Department of School Education and Literacy launched an integrated Centrally Sponsored Scheme for school education i.e. "Samagra Shiksha" with effect from the FY 2018-19. The scheme subsumes the three erstwhile Centrally Sponsored Schemes viz. "SarvaShiksh Abhiyan" (SSA), "Rashtriya Madhyamik Shiksha Abhiyan" (RMSA) and "Teacher Education". It envisages 'school' as a continuum from pre-school, primary, upper primary, secondary to senior secondary levels. The States/Union Territories are assisted by the Central Government to implement the Samagra Shiksha as a programme for providing universal access and retention, bridging the gender and social category in education and enhancement of learning level of children at all levels of school education including in tribal areas. The scheme is in accordance with Sustainable Development Goal (SDG) for Education and is aligned with the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020 i.e. to ensure inclusive and equitable, quality and holistic school education.

The Government of India has approved a new Centrally Sponsored Scheme, namely - Nav Bharat SakshartaKaryakram (New India Literacy Programme - NILP) to align with the National Education Policy 2020 and to support all the States and Union Territories in promoting literacy among non-literates.

(c): As informed by Department of School Education & Literacy, Ministry of Education, State-wise enrollment of Scheduled Tribe (ST) students (I-XII) for the year 2021-22 is given at **Annexure II**. The Gross Enrolment Ratio of ST students for the year 2021-22 in respect of Primary (I-V), Upper Primary (VI-VIII), Secondary (IX-X) and Higher Secondary (XI-XII) is 106.5, 97.95, 78.05 and 52.02 respectively. The pass percentage of ST Students for the year 2021-22 of 10th and 12th Standard is 75.87% and 83.72% respectively.
