The problems faced by farmers in Karnataka due to drought

श्री ईरण्ण कडाडी (कर्णाटक): उपसभापति महोदय, यह मुद्दा कर्णाटक राज्य से संबंधित है, इसलिए मैं कन्नड़ भाषा में बात करना चाहता हूँ।

*"Every Year, Karnataka receives 131 mm to 138 mm of rain, during two spells of monsoon period. However, in the current year, the rainfall has reduced from 47mm to 107mm. Karnataka has received 47% to 65% less rainfall this year. There are a total of 14 reservoirs in Karnataka, with a water storage capacity of 896 TMC. In the current year, these reservoirs have only 404 TMC of water. The gross water storage is

only 45%, that is, there has been a 55% reduction of water storage in these reservoirs in Karnataka.

The scarcity of rainfall has also resulted in the reduction of groundwater level. The groundwater level has decreased by 11%. As a result of this, 223 Talukas out of 236 have been declared as drought-prone. There is a very high possibility of drinking water scarcity in 600 village panchayats across the state. In Karnataka, 83 lakh hectares of land is cultivated every year. However, in the current year, only 74 lakh hectares of land is cultivated, out of which 48 lakh hectares of land has suffered crop loss due to severe scarcity of water for irrigation. There will be a severe shortage of fodder for livestock. It is extremely unfortunate, that around 456 farmers have committed suicide in this financial year. When the people of Karnataka are facing such serious problems, the Congress Government of Karnataka, instead of taking any effective measures, is pointing fingers at the Central Government. If we analyze the figures from 2006 to 2014, the Government led by Congress had allocated only 812 crore rupees to SDRF and 3,232 crore rupees to NDRF in Karnataka. The Central Government under the leadership of our Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi ji, has increased SDRF allocation to 2,778 crore rupees and NDRF allocation to 12,542 crore rupees, and still, the Karnataka State Government is criticizing the Central Government.

The Congress party has failed terribly to keep up their election promises. The Karnataka Government has not taken any steps to resolve the severe shortage of water. The false assurance and total failure of the Congress Government has left the farmers helpless. The only hope that the people of Karnataka have is in the form of our Prime Minister Narendra Modi ji. I hereby request the Central Government to intervene and help us to tackle this severe problem of drought. Namaskar ! "
