Will the Minister of Housing and Urban Affairs be pleased to state:

- (a) whether 3 projects for water supply, 2 projects for sewage and septage management, 4 projects for development of parks have been sanctioned for Tadepalligudem city in Andhra Pradesh under AMRUT with an estimated cost of ₹71 crore;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the projects have been completed and made operational; and
- (d) if not, the reasons for delay and by when they are likely to be completed?

(d): AMRUT empowers States/ Union Territories (UTs) to design, prioritize and implement the projects in respective Urban Local Bodies as per the Mission guidelines. Selection of projects and their implementation is the responsibility of the concerned State Governments. As reported by the State of Andhra Pradesh, the remaining projects under AMRUT were delayed due to delay in land acquisition for major components like Summer Storage Tank and Sewage Treatment Plant and also due to impact of COVID 19. The State Government has informed that the tentative date of completion of the remaining projects is December 2024.
