**STATUS OF COMMON FACILITY CENTRES UNDER MSE-CDP SCHEME**

- (a) the number of Common Facility Centres approved and completed under the MSE-Cluster Development Programme (CDP) scheme, State-wise including Odisha;
- (b) the amount of funds approved and released under the scheme, year-wise since 2015-16;
- (c) whether Government is aware that there has been an underutilisation of funds allocated under the scheme; and
- (d) if so, the reasons therefor?

(a): Total 235 projects of Common Facility Centres are approved out of which 100 projects have been completed under MSE-Cluster Development Programme (CDP), the State-wise detail including Odisha is **Annexed**.
