- (a) whether the Government has notified the new Aircraft Security Rules, 2023 and if so, the details thereof ;
- (b) whether the Government proposes to implement a biometric ID verification system and the details thereof; and;

- a) Yes, Sir. Aircraft (Security) Rules, 2023 have been notified in the Gazette of India on 09.08.2023 by repealing Aircraft (Security) Rules, 2011.
- b) Yes, Sir. Government is implementing Digi Yatra, a biometric-based ID verification system using Facial Recognition Technology, at airports in a phased manner.
- c) Yes, Sir. The strength of CISF has been increased to meet the security requirement at airports. Government is also continuously making efforts to improve security at airports by using advanced technologies.
