MISSION AMRIT SAROVAR IN KARNATAKA

Will the Minister of RURAL DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the aims and objectives of Mission Amrit Sarovar;
- (b) the details of Amrit Sarovars (Ponds) identified under Amrit Sarovar Mission in the State of Karnataka, district-wise; and
- (c) the status of developing/rejuvenation of Amrit Sarovars identified from Karnataka?

(a): The Mission Amrit Sarovar was launched on 24th April 2022, with an objective to conserve water for the future. As per initial target the Mission aimed at developing / rejuvenating 75 Amrit Sarovar (Pond) in each district of the Country, totaling about 50,000 Amrit Sarovars in the country. Amrit Sarovar has been a visible manifestation of the actions during Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav.
