Will the Minister of SOCIAL JUSTICE AND EMPOWERMENT be pleased to state:-

- (a) whether it is true that the Government is giving 1000 Junior Research Fellowships per year for OBC students for taking up advanced studies and research;
- (b) since M.Phil. has been removed, will the Ministry extend all 1000 JRFs for pursuing Ph.D. degree;
- (c) whether it is true that the Government has revised JFS amount last year and, if so, details thereof; and
- (d) what are the reasons that total scholars of JFR and SRF from Andhra Pradesh came down from 53 in 2019-20 to 45 in 2022-23?

- (c) Yes Sir, it is true that the Government has revised JRFs amount last year. The details are as follows:
