Impact assessment of PM-DevINE Scheme

1947. Shri Sandosh Kumar P:

Will the Minister of Development of North Eastern Region be pleased to state:

- (a) the total funds allocated for the Prime Minister's Development Initiative for North Eastern Region (PM-DevINE) scheme since its inception;
- (b) the total funds utilised under the Scheme in each State;
- (c) the current status of the projects funded under the Scheme;
- (d) whether there has been any evaluation studies to assess the impact of the Scheme; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof?

- (a) & (b) Prime Minister's Development Initiative for North East Region (PM-DevINE) scheme was approved by the Union Cabinet on 12 October, 2022 with a total outlay of Rs.6,600 crore for the 4-year period from 2022-23 to 2025-26.

Since inception in October, 2022 and upto 24.07.2024, total 31 projects worth Rs.4502.46 crore have been sanctioned under PM-DevINE scheme against the approved outlay. State-wise details are as under:
