**CARBON AND WATER NEUTRAL HEAVY INDUSTRIES**

557. SHRI B. PARTHASARADHI REDDY:

Will the Minister of HEAVY INDUSTRIES be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government has mandated heavy industry PSUs to transition to net zero and water-neutral companies;
- (b) if so, the details of the heavy industry PSUs that have initiated the transition;
- (c) whether Government has mandated heavy industries to undergo emission and water utility assessment; and
- (d) if so, the details of the assessment PSUs-wise, if not, the reasons therefor?
