STATEMENT IN REPLY TO PARTS (a) TO (e) OF RAJYA SABHA STARRED QUESTION NO.114 ANSWERED ON 01.08.2024 REGARDING DEVELOPMENT OF TOURISM IN TELANGANA RAISED BY SHRI RAVI CHANDRA VADDIRAJU

(a) to (e): The Ministry of Tourism through its central sector schemes of ‘Swadesh Darshan’ (SD) and ‘Pilgrimage Rejuvenation and Spiritual, Heritage Augmentation Drive’ (PRASHAD) complements the efforts of tourism infrastructure development by extending financial assistance to the State Governments/UT Administrations including the State of Telangana. The Ministry of Tourism has sanctioned 3 projects each under its Swadesh Darshan and PRASHAD schemes in the State of Telangana. Further, under its scheme of ‘Assistance to Central Agencies’, the Ministry of Tourism has sanctioned 2 projects in Telangana. The details of the projects sanctioned under SD, PRASHAD and Assistance to Central Agencies schemes is **annexed**.

The Ministry of Tourism has recently revamped the Swadesh Darshan Scheme as Swadesh Darshan 2.0 (SD2.0) with the objective to develop sustainable and responsible tourism destinations, following a destination & tourism-centric approach. In consultation with the States/UTs and in line with the scheme guidelines, the Ministry has accordingly identified 57 destinations in the country for development under SD 2.0 including ‘Bhongir’ & ‘Ananthagiri’ in Telangana and has sanctioned following projects/interventions in the financial year 2023-24 at these destinations:

The Ministry of Tourism has also issued guidelines for ‘Challenge Based Destination Development’ (CBDD), a sub-scheme under Swadesh Darshan 2.0, under which the Ministry of Tourism has identified 42 destinations for development in the country including ‘Nalgonda’ and ‘Kamareddy’ in Telangana. The Ministry has further identified ‘Balkampet Yellamma Temple’, Hyderabad for development under PRASHAD scheme.
