**STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PARTS (a) TO (f) OF RAJYA SABHA STARRED QUESTION NO. 119 FOR 01.08.2024 BY DR. V. SIVADASAN REGARDING VARIOUS STATISTICS OF ESIC HOSPITALS.**

**(a): As on 31.03.2023, there were total 13,30,73,951 beneficiaries under the Employees' State Insurance (ESI) scheme.**

**(b): At present, there are 165 ESI hospitals and 1695 ESI dispensaries across the country, out of which 59 ESI hospitals and 141 ESI dispensaries including Dispensary-cum-Branch Office (DCBOs) are run by the Employees' State Insurance Corporation (ESIC).**

**(c) & (d): At present, there are total 2675 regular doctors and 9442 nursing and paramedical staff in the ESI hospitals and dispensaries run by the ESIC.**

**(e): The state wise details of the vacancies of doctors including nursing and paramedical staff in ESI hospitals and dispensaries run by the ESI Corporation are placed at Annexure.**

**(f): The details of new appointments made by the ESIC in last three years including in the year 2024 (upto 31.03.2024) are as under:**
