- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) the incumbency position as on 1st July, 2024 in respect of all aided Institutes, all Public Sector Undertakings under aegis of the Ministry of Communications; and
- (d) whether Government has initiated any special recruitment drive for filling up of vacancies in SC/ST/OBC and minority communities and if so, the details thereof, if not, the reasons therefor?

- (a) & (b) Recruitment to fill up vacant posts is a continuous process and is being done through various modes of recruitment *inter alia* including promotion by holding Departmental Promotion Committee and departmental examination, and direct recruitment through Union Public Service Commission and Staff Selection Commission.
