PM-DevINE Scheme for North East Region

1151. Smt. Darshana Singh:

Will the Minister of Development of North Eastern Region be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government has initiated / approved a new scheme, namely, Prime Minister's Development Initiative for North East Region (PM-DevINE), if so, the details thereof;
- (b) the salient features and aims and objectives of the said Scheme;
- (c) the details of total funds earmarked and sanctioned by the Central Government under the said Scheme till now;
- (d) the details of major infrastructure projects sanctioned under the said Scheme; and
- (e) whether the said Scheme has already been implemented, if not, the time by which the said Scheme will come into force/ will be implemented?

ANSWER

(a) to (c) Yes, Sir. Prime Minister's Development Initiative for North East Region (PM-DevINE) was announced as a new Central Sector scheme with 100% Central funding in the Union Budget 2022-23. It was approved by the Union Cabinet on 12 October, 2022 with a total outlay of Rs.6,600 crore for the 4-year period from 2022-23 to 2025-26 and aimed at rapid and holistic development of NER by funding infrastructure and social development projects based on the felt needs of the States.

The objectives of PM-DevINE scheme are to: (i) fund infrastructure convergently, in the spirit of PM GatiShakti; (ii) support social development projects based on felt needs of the NER; (iii)

enable livelihood activities for youth and women; and (iv) fill the development gaps in various sectors.

(d) Since its inception in October 2022, total 31 projects worth **Rs.4502.46 crore** including infrastructure projects have been sanctioned upto 25.07.2024 under PM-DevINE scheme. A list of these projects is given at **Annexure**.

(e) Yes, Sir. The scheme has come into force with effect from 12thOctober, 2022.
