**BYPASSES ON HIGHWAYS**

**265. SHRI KESRIDEVSINH JHALA:**

Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government has received proposals from States or requests from Members of Parliament for providing bypasses in cities;
- (b) if so, the details thereof, State-wise;
- (c) the status of construction of bypasses to be considered or implemented; and
- (d) the time to complete the bypasses in all States?

**ANSWER**

(a) to (d) The Ministry is primarily responsible for development and maintenance of National Highways (NHs). Proposals of Bypasses / Ring Roads on NHs across the country are taken up based on traffic volume, requirement of safety and efficient mobility, removal of congestion at intersections, land constraints, subject to inter-se priority and availability of funds.
