Will the Minister of CIVIL AVIATION be pleased to state:-

(a) whether Government releases funds for maintenance and repair of old airports/aerodromes and if so, whether a tender form has been issued for the repair of old buildings constructed at Shimla Airport of Himachal Pradesh;

(b) if so, by when the repair work of the said buildings would be completed; and

(c) whether Government keeping in view the increasing tourism in Shimla, proposes to increase the number of aircrafts of other airlines other than Alliance Air from Shimla Airport, if so, the companies with which agreements have been signed, if not, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

Minister of State in the Ministry of CIVIL AVIATION (Shri Murlidhar Mohol)

(a) & (b): The upgradation of infrastructure/facilities at airports including maintenance and repair of old airports/ aerodromes, is a continuous process, undertaken by the Airports Authority of India (AAI) or the concerned Airport Operators depending upon operational requirements, traffic, demand, commercial feasibility, availability of land etc. For Shimla Airport in Himachal Pradesh, the Airports Authority of India (AAI) has allocated a budget of Rs. 1.50 crore for civil and electrical maintenance in the FY 2024-25. Tenders have been issued and the Annual Maintenance Work has already been awarded.

(c): The Government of India in its endeavor to promote regional and remote connectivity, launched Regional Connectivity Scheme (RCS-UDAN) on 21.10.2016. As part of the UDAN initiative, Alliance Air currently operates flights to and from Shimla connecting with Delhi & Amritsar. Under the UDAN Scheme, the Government has also conducted bidding rounds to promote air connectivity through Helicopters. So far, RCS routes connecting Shimla (with Fixed Wing and Helicopters) as detailed in Annexure-A, have been awarded to the Selected Airline Operators for the operation of flights.
