DRINKING WATER FACILITIES

88. SHRI IRANNA KADADI:

Will the Minister of JAL SHAKTI be pleased to State:

- (a) the steps taken by Government to provide drinking water facilities to all the people in the country;
- (b) whether Government proposes to formulate any action plan for the revival of ancient sources of drinking water to deal with the serious crisis of drinking water;
- (c) if so, the details thereof, State-wise, particularly in Karnataka;
- (d) the details of dams which have been included in the said scheme as major sources of drinking water in rural/urban areas of Karnataka; and
- (e) the time by when the target of supplying water to the respective dams would be achieved along with name of the schemes?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF JAL SHAKTI (SHRI V. SOMANNA)

(a) to (c) Government of India is committed to make provision for safe & potable tap water supply in adequate quantity, of prescribed quality and on a regular & long-term basis to all rural households in the country. Towards this end, the Government of India launched the Jal Jeevan Mission (JJM), to be implemented in partnership with States including Karnataka, in August 2019. Drinking Water is a State subject, and hence, the responsibility of planning, approval, implementation, operation, and maintenance of drinking water supply schemes, including those under the Jal Jeevan Mission, lies with State/UT Governments. The Government of India supports the States by providing technical and financial assistance.

Significant progress has been made in the country since the launch of Jal Jeevan Mission, towards enhancing access to tap water to rural households. At the start of Jal Jeevan Mission in August 2019, only 3.23 Crore (16.75%) rural households were reported to have tap water connections. So far, as reported by States/ UTs as on 18.07.2024, around 11.75 Crore additional rural households

have been provided with tap water connections under JJM. Thus, as on 18.07.2024, out of 19.32 Crore rural households in the country, around 14.99 Crore (77.58%) households are reported to have tap water supply in their homes.

The water sources which *inter alia* include groundwater (open well, borewell, tube well, handpumps, etc.), surface water (river, reservoir, lake, pond, springs, etc.) and rainwater stored in small tanks are being used as sources for drinking water supply schemes. Under JJM, provisions have been made for development/ strengthening/ augmentation of drinking water sources; and infrastructure for bulk transfer, treatment and distribution systems in water deficit drought-prone and desert areas without dependable ground water sources apart from creation of in-village water supply infrastructure.

In addition, provisions for taking up augmentation and strengthening of local drinking water sources in convergence with other schemes at village level viz. MGNREGS, 15th Finance Commission tied grants to RLBs/ PRIs, Integrated Watershed Management Programme (IWMP), State schemes, District Mineral Development Fund, CSR funds, community contribution, etc. is also envisaged under the JJM.

Further, Jal Shakti Abhiyan: Catch the Rain (JSA: CTR) campaign aiming to encourage water conservation at grass-root levels with people's participation was launched in 2019 in 256 water stressed districts of the country. Moreover, recognizing the importance of sustainable water management especially for drinking water availability, JSA-CTR was implemented with the theme "Source Sustainability for Drinking Water" in 2023. Similarly, in 2024, JSA is being implemented with the theme "Nari Shakti se Jal Shakti" from 09.03.2024 to 30.11.2024 emphasizing the pivotal role played by women in the field of water conservation.

As informed by the State Government of Karnataka, the Rural Development and Panchayati Raj Department has been implementing check dams and borewells recharge structures to rejuvenate borewells.

(d) & (e) Further, as informed by State Government of Karnataka, the major sources of rural water supply projects are located upstream and downstream of the Almatti Dam, Narayanpur Dam, Tunga Bhandra Dam, Krishna Raja Sagar Dam, Linganmakki Dam, Bhadra Dam and Gorur Dam and target is to provide treated water from major Dams by March, 2026. A list of schemes is enclosed in **Annexure**.
