REDUCTION IN AREA UNDER AGRICULTURE

504. SMT. JEBI MATHER HISHAM:

Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE AND FARMERS WELFARE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government has compiled data on the extent of agricultural land reduced over the period from 2018-19 to 2023-24, if so, the details thereof, State/UT-wise;
- (b) reduction in food crop production in the backdrop of reduced farmland, the details thereof, State/UT-wise; and
- (c) whether Government has formulated any alternatives to boost food crop production despite the reduction in farmland, if so, the details thereof, State-wise?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF THE AGRICULTURE AND FARMERS WELFARE

(a) & (b): As per the latest published Land Use Statistics-at a Glance 2012-13 to 2021-22, the area of agricultural land in the country has reduced from 1,80,624 thousand hectares in 2018-19 to 1,80,112 thousand hectare in 2021-22. The state wise details of Agricultural land/cultivable land/arable land in the country from the year 2018-19 to 2021-22 are given at Annexure-I. However, as per 3rd Advance Estimates for the year 2023-24, food grains production in the country has increased from 2852.09 lakh tonnes during the year 2018-19 to 3288.52 lakh tonnes in 2023-24. The State-wise details of the food grains production in the country from the year 2018-19 to 2023-24 are given at Annexure-II.

(c): Government has adopted and implemented several policies, reforms, developmental programmes and schemes for boosting food crop production for the farmers directly or indirectly in the country. The unprecedented enhanced budgetary provisions have been made to facilitate the following efforts of the Government:
