VACANCIES IN GOVERNMENT DEPARTMENTS

432 DR. JOHN BRITTAS:

Will the **PRIME MINISTER** be pleased to state:

- (a) the category-wise total sanctioned strength of posts and the vacancies thereon in Government Departments, as-on-date;
- (b) the steps taken to fill the vacancies;
- (c) the number of posts abolished during last five years in Government Departments;
- (d) the category-wise details thereof;
- (e) the number of new appointments made during the last five years; and
- (f) the year-wise and category-wise details thereof?

(a) to (f): In the matter of appointment, by direct recruitment to civil posts and civil services under the Central Government, on all India basis by open competition, reservation is provided to SCs, STs and OBCs @15%, 7.5% and 27% respectively. In the matter of promotions in the Central Government, reservation is provided up to the lowest rung of Group 'A' @ 15% and 7.5% to SCs and STs respectively. The persons belonging to EWSs who are not covered under the scheme of reservation for SCs, STs and OBCs are provided 10% reservation in direct recruitment in civil posts and services in the Government of India.

Occurrence and filling up of vacant posts in various Ministries/Departments is a continuous process. The data regarding vacancies is maintained by respective Ministries/Departments. Ministries/ Departments of the Central Government have been directed, from time to time, to fill up vacant posts in a time bound manner. Vacant posts have been filled up in mission mode, in Rozgar Mela launched by Hon'ble Prime Minister on 22nd October, 2022. 12 Rozgar Melas have been held at central level at 45-50 cities across the various States/ Union Territories.
