Will the Minister of CORPORATE AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) The total amount of Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) funds collected and spent in various States during the last five years, the details thereof, State-wise and district-wise for the State of Punjab;
- (b) The details of key sectors where CSR funds had been spent in various States during the last five years, Statewise;
- (c) Whether impact assessments of CSR proposals have been conducted or are being planned; and
- (d) If so, the details thereof, especially for the projects of Punjab?

(a) & (b): The legal framework for Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) has been provided under Section 135 of the Companies Act, 2013 ('Act'), Schedule VII of the Act and Companies (CSR Policy) Rules, 2014. The CSR Framework under the Companies Act, 2013 ('the Act') is disclosure based and CSR mandated companies are required to file details of CSR activities annually in the MCA21 registry. All data related to CSR filed by companies in MCA21 registry including company-wise, state-wise, district-wise and development sector-wise is available in public domain at www.csr.gov.in. On the basis of annual filings made by Companies in the MCA21 registry, the details of CSR spent in the last five years State-wise & development sector-wise are attached as Annexure-I & II respectively. Further, district-wise details of CSR spent for the state of Punjab is attached as Annexure-III.

(c) & (d): The relevant provisions of Impact Assessments have been provided under Rule 8 of the Companies (CSR Policy) Amendment Rules, 2021 w.e.f. 22nd January, 2021 which contains provisions related to impact assessment of CSR projects by certain class of companies. Further, the said rule also requires that the impact assessment be conducted by an independent agency. The Board has the prerogative to decide on the eligibility criteria for selection of the independent agency for Impact Assessment.
