**STRATEGIES FOR EFFECTIVE IMPLEMENTATION OF SBM (G) II**

713. SHRI MUKUL BALKRISHNA WASNIK:

Will the Minister of JAL SHAKTI be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that the Swachh Bharat Mission (Grameen)-II [SBM (G)-II] focuses on sustainability of Open Defecation Free (ODF) status and Solid and Liquid Waste Management in rural areas of the country;
- (b) if so, the details of the Mission including the goals set and the actual performance on all the parameters of the scheme, State-wise; and
- (c) the strategies adopted by Government for effective implementation of the scheme in States that have been slow in making progress and the timeframe for fulfilling the objectives of the Mission?

(a) Yes Sir.

(b) The goal of Swachh Bharat Mission (Grameen) [SBM(G)] Phase-II is to sustain the Open Defecation Free (ODF) status of villages and to cover all villages with Solid Waste Management (SWM), Liquid Waste Management (LWM) and visually clean by 2024-25 to make them from ODF to ODF Plus Model. The State/UT-wise details of Open Defecation Free (ODF) Plus Model villages is at **Annexure-I**.

(c) Department of Drinking Water and Sanitation is continuously pursuing with the States/UTs and supporting them so that implementation of the programme can be speeded up at ground level. Regular review meetings, technical workshops with the States/UTs are being conducted. The field visits are also undertaken by the Ministry's officers to review the programme at ground level and to know the issues being faced by the State/UT in implementation of the programme.
