BENEFICIARIES UNDER AB-PMJAY

904. SMT. GEETA ALIAS CHANDRAPRABHA:

Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) the total number of beneficiaries of Ayushman Bharat Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojana(AB -PMJAY) in the country;
- (b) the total number of beneficiaries in the country benefited from this scheme in the last two years;
- (c) the total number of beneficiaries of the AB-PMJAY Yojana in the State of Uttar Pradesh;
- (d) whether it is a fact that some States of the country have not implemented AB-PMJAY in their State; and
- (e) if so, the details of the concerned States and the efforts being made by Government to implement the scheme in these States?

ANSWER THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SHRI PRATAPRAO JADHAV)

- (a) and (b): Ayushman Bharat Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojana (AB-PMJAY) is the world's largest publicly funded health assurance scheme which provides health cover of Rs. 5 lakhs per family per year for secondary and tertiary care hospitalization to approximately 55 crore beneficiaries corresponding to 12.34 crore families, constituting the bottom 40% of India's population. States/UTs implementing AB-PMJAY have further expanded the beneficiary base at their own cost. A total number of 3.57 crore beneficiaries in the country benefited under the scheme in the last two years.
- (c): In the State of Uttar Pradesh, AB-PMJAY is implemented in convergence with the State scheme. At present, approximately 1.8 crore families, including State scheme beneficiaries, are provided healthcare cover under the converged scheme.
- (d) and (e): States/UT of Odisha, West Bengal and Delhi are not implementing the scheme. Government of India is pursuing with these States/UT to join the scheme so that eligible beneficiaries are not deprived of healthcare benefits.
