MICRO AND DRIP IRRIGATION IN DELTA REGIONS OF THANJAVUR

Will the Minister of JAL SHAKTI be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government has any plans to introduce micro irrigation and/or drip irrigation in the delta regions of Thanjavur and the details thereof; and
- (b) if not, the reasons therefor?

(a) & (b) Under Per Drop More Crop (PDMC) scheme being implemented by Department of Agriculture and Farmers Welfare (DoA&FW), Government of India is providing subsidy for on-farm micro irrigation equipment in the country, including the State of Tamil Nadu. The scheme focuses on enhancing water use efficiency at farm level through drip and sprinkler irrigation systems.

PDMC was earlier implemented by DoA&FW was a component of the umbrella scheme Pradhan Mantri Krishi Sinchayee Yojana (PMKSY). However, from the year 2021 onwards, it is being implemented by DoA&FW as a part of Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana (RKVY).

An area of 22,433 hectare has been covered under micro irrigation through PDMC in Thanjavur district of Tamil Nadu, from the year 2015-16, till date.
